 Dock Permit Application Checklist

Please submit the following information and use the check boxes to ensure a complete application is filed for a dock permit. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

- A completed right-of-way permit application and payment.
- Scaled drawings of the project and structural calculations. Five sets of drawings and three sets of calculations must be submitted.
 - Drawings must include the location of the Wharfage Easement.
 - All Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be shown on the drawings.
 - If existing piles are proposed to remain, the applicant must submit a report that is created, signed, and stamped by a registered engineer with the state of California who is competent in waterfront structural inspection; the report must review the structural condition in detail of each pile that is proposed to remain.
- Location and physical dimensions of the *existing* dock structure (dock, pile(s), gangway).
- Location and physical dimensions of the *proposed* dock structures (dock, pile(s), gangway).
- Coastal Permit Determination
- Set of signed and stamped plans from the Coronado Cays Homeowners Association’s Architectural and Environmental Control Committee
- Identify if the project is within City jurisdiction or the San Diego Unified Port District jurisdiction.

I, _____ (applicant/ agent), hereby certify that the information on this application is accurate and complete. I also certify that by acceptance of this Permit, the applicant acknowledges and agrees that the site may be subject to hazards from waves and erosion.

I will further hold the City of Coronado harmless from and indemnify the City against any claim for damages arising out of the exercise of these permits. In addition, I shall reimburse the City of Coronado for all attorney’s fees and other costs expended by them in defending any claim, lawsuit, or judgment arising out of the activities of the applicant carried on under the authority of such Permit.

I understand that a copy of the approval from Army Corps of Engineers must be submitted before permit issuance and any work authorized must be completed within six months of permit approval.
