

Spreckels Park Restroom

The existing Spreckels Park restroom has reached the end of its service life, does not comply with current ADA requirements, nor does it adequately serve the increased demands of the events that occur at Spreckels Park. The new, larger ADA-compliant restroom is designed with a brick exterior and metal roof with skylights to illuminate the restroom interiors. The project also includes two new mosaic murals and restoration of the existing mural. In addition to the new restroom, the project will replace the existing park electrical components to improve reliability and flexibility for the many park activities such as Concerts in the Park and the Flower Show. To meet the needs of visitors at larger events, the project will provide two decorative pads and infrastructure for the installation of temporary trailer restrooms, replacing the “porta potties” that have been used in the past. Work is anticipated to start after the last concert of 2016 and be completed prior to the 2017 Flower Show.
