

## **Dock C and Boat Launch Ramp Replacement**

Construction is underway for replacement of the existing Glorietta Bay Dock C with a more durable system and one that meets ADA, fire, and Department of Boating and Waterways requirements. The new dock will moor 34 boats to meet the current demand for wider and larger sizes. The new docks are expected to be operational as of July 1, 2017.

The Glorietta Bay Boat Launch Ramp has been in continuous operation for more than 40 years and is beyond its service life. The project will provide a new ramp surface with better traction for launching and retrieving boats. The dock at the ramp will be removed and replaced with a new dock to comply with ADA and Department of Boating and Waterways requirements. The new dock will provide space for temporary public tie ups and a low freeboard dock for kayaks, paddleboards, and rowing sculls. The project will also include a new sandy beach for launching boats from the shore, a temporary parking area for car-carried craft, and a larger and improved boat wash-off area.

Funding for this project is from the Port of San Diego, City of Coronado Marina Fund, and a grant from the Department of Boating and Waterways.

The Boat Launch Ramp is now open! It will be closed temporarily for one day, after the July 4th Holiday, so that the parking lot can be restriped.
