The City of Coronado (hereinafter "CITY") offers to the public an opportunity to train with Coronado Beach Lifeguards to become more familiar with the Lifeguard's operations and procedures (hereinafter "PROGRAM"). The PROGRAM requires the undersigned to perform physical activities with the supervising Lifeguards such as but not limited to beach runs, ocean swims and various other activities and instructions to prepare the undersigned for the Lifeguard Academy. As the undersigned, I hereby acknowledge that my participation in the PROGRAM is undertaken as my own free will and does not constitute an expressed or implied contract of employment. I am aware that all interested applicants must still apply through the website, meet the minimum qualifications, pass the examination process and then be offered a position of Beach Lifeguard with CITY. **I further acknowledge that my participation in the PROGRAM is taken at my own personal risk. I fully recognize the physical and inherent dangers involved in the swimming, running, and mock rescue drills included as part of the PROGRAM.**

I assume these risks and hereby agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the CITY, it's elected and appointed officers, officials, agents, employees and volunteers from and against any and all causes of action, claims, liabilities, obligations, judgments, losses, or damages, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs of litigation ("claims") arising out of, or in connection with, the my participation in the PROGRAM excepting only loss, injury, damage or cost that arise out of the CITY's intentional wrongful acts, violations of law, or sole active negligence. It is further agreed and understood that all of my rights against the CITY under Section 1542 of the Civil Code of the State of California and any similar law of any state or territory of the United States are hereby expressly waived. Section 1542 reads as follows:

A general release does not extend to the claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which, if known by him, must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor.

I acknowledge that the CITY does not have medical or workers compensation insurance which applies to my participation in the PROGRAM and that I am solely responsible for my own medical insurance and medical expenses.

I, the undersigned, represent and warrant that I have read and fully understand the above statements and I fully understand this Release, Waiver and Assumption of Risk and thereupon affix my signature below.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BEACH LIFEGUARD TRAINING CAMP:

1. Please return completed form to the assigned Beach Lifeguard prior to the start of camp.
2. Participants must be 16 years of age or older.
3. You must obey all safety and lawful instructions given by the Lifeguard with whom you train.
4. Any information you may become privy to while participating in the Training Camp Program that the Lifeguard tells you is confidential – must remain confidential.
5. At no time may you represent yourself as a Beach Lifeguard unless you are a State of California appointed Beach Lifeguard.
6. Your behavior during the Training Camp must not cause discredit to the Beach Lifeguards. The Lifeguards running the camp may terminate the you from the camp if you display any unacceptable behavior or behavior that would discredit the Coronado Beach Lifeguards.
7. You must be dressed and groomed in a manner that will leave a favorable impression with the public. Attire must conform to acceptable standards. Clothing must appropriate for the activities you will be performing and not be exceptionally provocative.
8. All training camps will be scheduled in advance
9. No person shall be permitted to participate in the program if he/she arrives with the odor of alcohol on his/her breath, appears to be intoxicated, or has taken medication that might impair judgment, safety or ability to follow directions during the training camps.
10. Applicants must have no physical or mental disabilities that may be aggravated or would hinder the applicant's ability to comprehend or follow instructions during the training camps.
11. **No participant shall be permitted unless the RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK REGARDING TRAINING CAMPS FOR BEACH LIFEGUARD is read, completed, and signed. Participants under the age of 18 years must have a parent or legal guardian sign the Waiver form in person in view of the Lifeguards prior to the start of camp.**
