Insurance required: An original Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement must be filed with this application which complies with the following requirements (refer to Section 993, Title 19 and 12611, California Health & Safety Code):

- The licensed pyrotechnic operator supervising/discharging the display and the City of Coronado, its elected and appointed officers, officials, agents, representatives, employees and volunteers must be listed as additional insured. If the policy contains a blanket additional insured, then the certificate must note: "City of Coronado is additional insured by blanket endorsement."
- The deductible (if any) may not exceed fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00). Limits of bodily injury and property damage may not be less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) combined single limits for each occurrence annually and two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) aggregate.
- The Insurance Company must be licensed to do business in California.
- A statement must be included that the insurer will not cancel the insured's coverage without 15 days prior written notice to the City of Coronado Fire Marshal.

CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

_____ I/we hereby make application for a permit to conduct a display of fireworks as defined in the California State Health and Safety Code, and agree to comply in every particular with the law pertaining thereto as set forth in Part 2 of Division II of the Health and Safety Code, the Rules and Regulations adopted by the State Fire Marshal, The 2019 California Fire Code, NFPA 1123, Code for Fireworks Display 2022 Edition.

_____ I/we understand that firework displays may be permitted in a designated outdoor location provided that it complies with the requirements within this document and the California Fire Code. I/we understand that application does not guarantee approval or issuance of permit.

_____ I/we will obtain contact the Federal Aviation Authority and Naval Base Coronado to obtain approval or verification that the fireworks display will not interfere with their regular operations.

_____ I/we have included complete description of all fireworks to be displayed, specifying if single or multiple break shells and size. If set pieces are used, they shall be described in detail. I/we will provide a complete description of additional items to be used. I/we understand that a three-inch shell is the maximum allowable shell size and only the licensed technician may shoot fireworks.

_____ Equipment may be brought onto the beach for set-up no earlier three (3) hours prior to the show. Only if necessary, one vehicle shall be allowed on the beach at a time. One person will always walk ahead of the vehicle to ensure a clear path of travel and the vehicle will maintain a slow, safe speed. I/we will call the Main Lifeguard Tower at (619) 522-7346 upon arrival to obtain clearance.

_____ I/we will use snow fencing or a similar material to cordon off an area of at least 100 feet in radius around the discharge site, prior to fireworks unloading and setup. I/we will use snow fencing or a similar material to cordon off a Safety Fall-Out Zone in all directions from the beach launch site no sooner than one (1) hour prior to firing to assure public safety. The size of the Safety Fall-Out Zone is determined by multiplying the diameter of the largest shell being used by 70 feet. To secure the perimeter, I/we will maintain at least four (4) security officers to make sure no unauthorized people enter the Safety Fall-Out Zone during the fireworks show.

_____ I/we will maintain an emergency vehicle lane all times to allow for the access of emergency vehicles to all areas of the City beach. All areas will remain accessible in the event of an emergency and immediate access will be given to any emergency vehicles and/or personnel in the area.

_____ I/we will coordinate with the Coronado Fire Department for a permit check and inspection prior to the fireworks show to ensure all conditions of the fireworks permit have been met and that the weather conditions do not jeopardize the safety of beach users or surrounding structures.

_____ I/we will clean the beach of trash, ash, or any other debris at the conclusion of the event.

_____ I/we will conduct a "dud sweep" at first light the morning after the fireworks display.

_____ I/we will notify all affected agencies in writing of the fireworks display and will place an ad in the local newspaper*.

I understand that violation of any of the above conditions could result in administrative fines or fees, or the denial of future fireworks display permits.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

The person(s) requesting use of City property, facilities or personnel shall obtain, and during the term of this Permit shall maintain, a comprehensive general liability and property damage insurance policy covering all activities and all liabilities from a carrier authorized to do business in the State of California in an amount not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence and two million dollars (\$2,000,000) aggregate and, if applicable, Commercial Automobile Liability Insurance for all any automobiles (any auto) providing coverage for bodily injury and property damage of at least one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence.

The insurance policies must name the City and its elected and appointed officers, officials, agents and employees as “additional insureds.” The City must be provided with a Certificate(s) of Insurance and Policy Endorsement(s) naming the City and its elected and appointed officers, officials, agents, representatives, employees and volunteers as “additional insureds” and reflecting that the policies are primary and noncontributory to any insurance that may be carried by the City. If applicable, the same person(s) shall obtain, and during the term of this Permit shall maintain, Workers’ Compensation Insurance in an insurable amount of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or statutory minimum amount, as required by California law with a blanket waiver of subrogation. The Risk Management Department may require additional verification, different coverages or higher limits depending on the nature of activities.

Upon approval of the attached *Application for Permit for Public Display of Fireworks* by the City, the undersigned named organization, through its duly authorized representative, does hereby indemnify, defend (with counsel acceptable to City) and hold harmless the City of Coronado, its elected and appointed officers, officials, agents, employees and volunteers (“City Indemnitees”) from and against any and all causes of action, claims, liabilities, obligations, judgments, losses, or damages, including, but not limited to reasonable attorneys’ fees and costs of litigation, (“Claims”) arising out of, or in connection with, the attached approved *Application for Permit for Public Display of Fireworks* (“Permit”), including, but not limited to, the activities, use or conduct in connection with the Permit, or any act or omission related thereto by the named organization or its officers, directors, members, agents, employees, contractors, representatives, guests, invitees, customers or volunteers.

The named organization shall provide a defense to the City Indemnitees or, at the City’s option, reimburse the City Indemnitees their costs of defense, including reasonable attorneys’ fees, incurred in defense of such Claims; and the named organization shall promptly pay any final judgment or portion thereof rendered against the City Indemnitees with respect to claims determined by a trier of fact to have been the result of the named organization’s negligent or wrongful acts, errors, or omissions, provided. The named organization’s obligation herein does not extend to liabilities, claims, demands, causes of action, losses, damages or costs that arise solely out of the City’s intentional wrongful acts, City’s violations of law, or gross negligence.

This *Release of Liability, Waiver and Assumption of Risk* shall not be limited by any provision of insurance coverage the named organization may have in effect, or may be required to obtain and maintain, during the term of the Permit. The named organization assumes the risk of inspecting the City property to assure that it is safe for the purposes intended in the Permit. The named organization assumes the risk of any injury to the named organization or to the named organization’s guests, invitees, or customers, or to property resulting or arising from or in connection with the Permit or the use of the City facilities or property. The provisions of this document shall survive the expiration or termination of the Permit.

The person executing this document on behalf of, and duly authorized by, the named organization, represents and warrants to the City of Coronado that he or she has the authority to execute this *Release of Liability, Waiver, and Assumption of Risks*, and that he or she has read and understands the above statements fully, freely agrees to them and thereupon affixes his or her signature below.

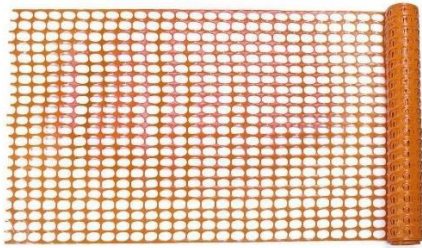

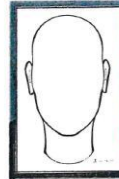
SNOW FENCING SAMPLE

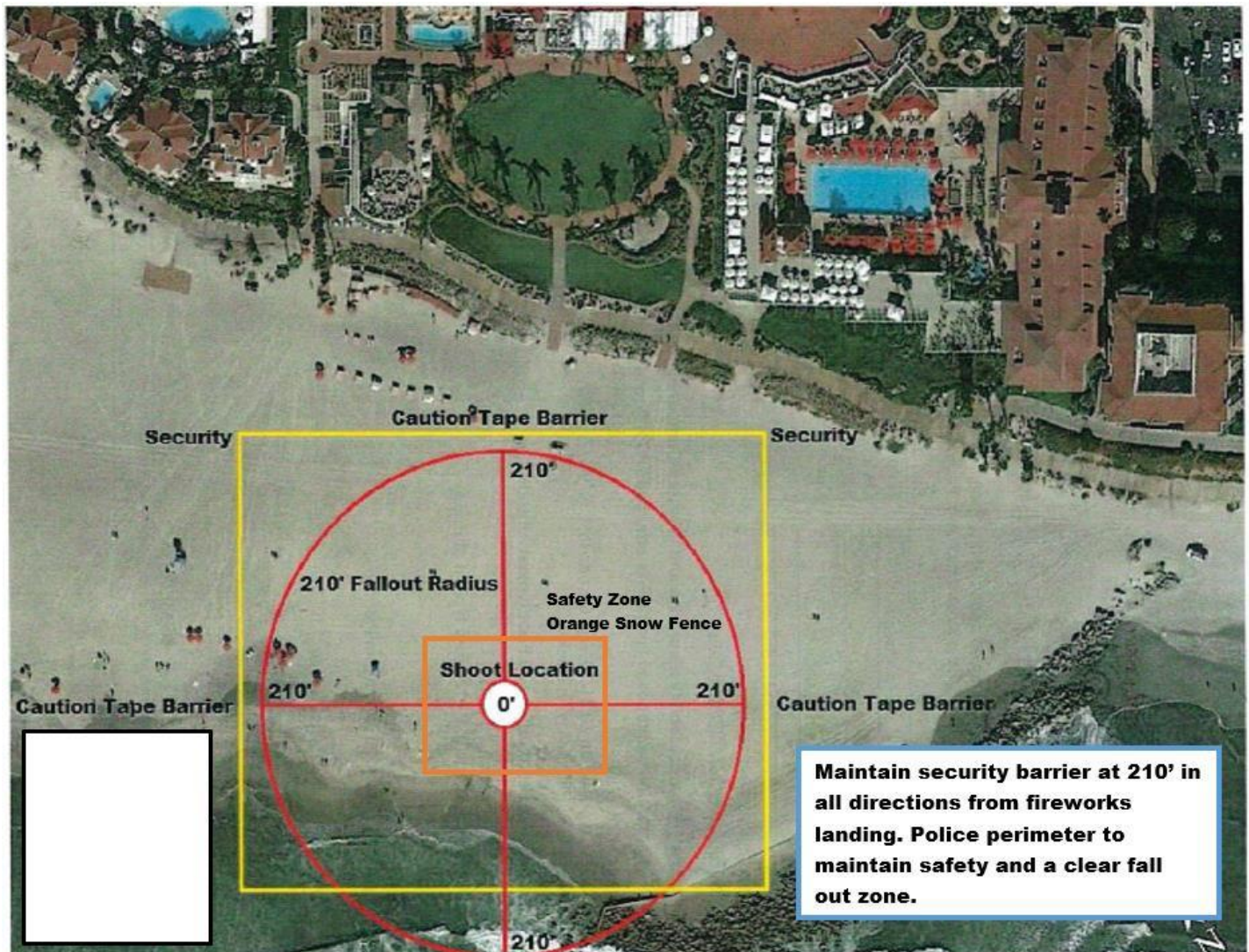

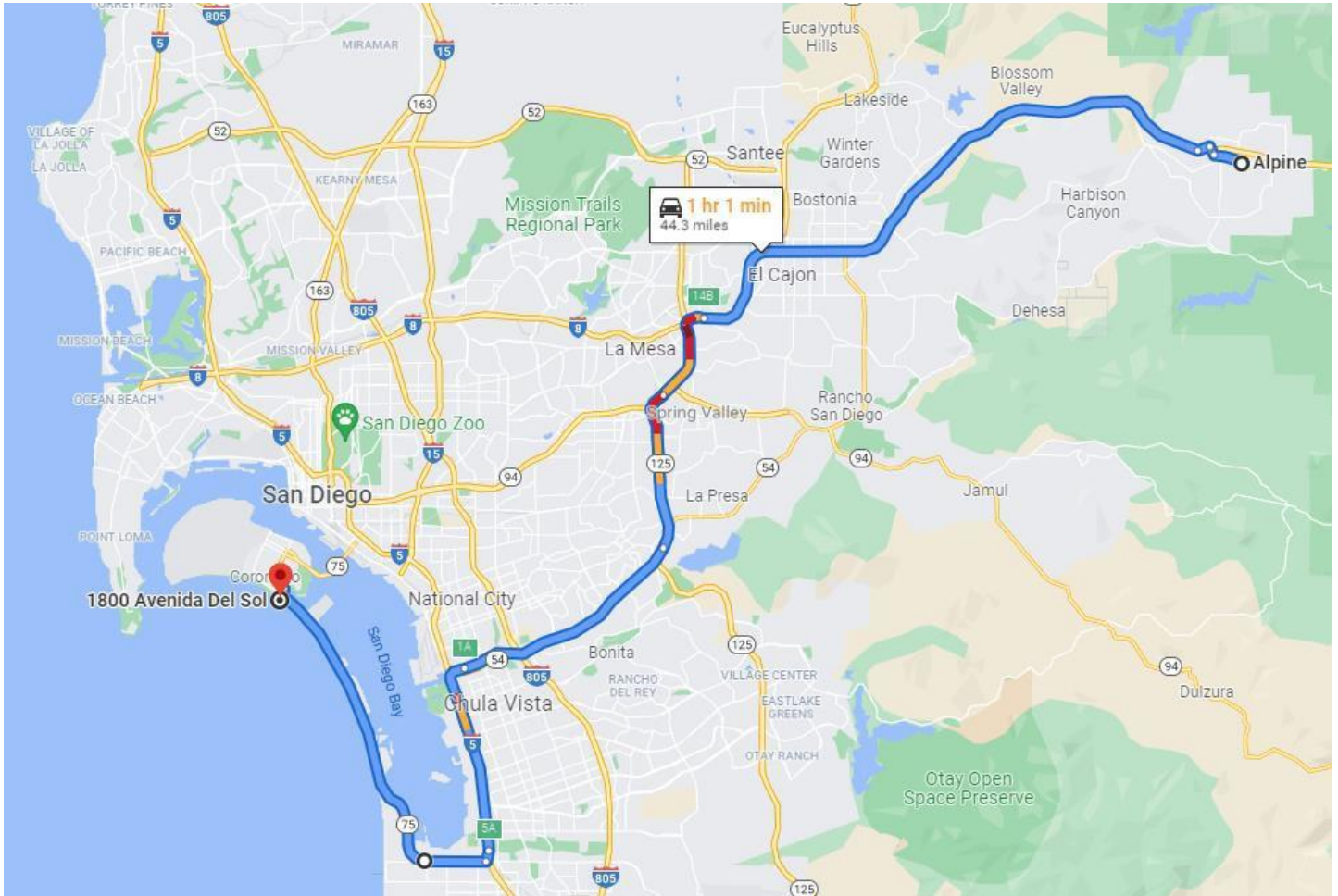
