

# **TransNet**

## History:

1987 – San Diego County voters approved TransNet, the 20-year ½-cent sales tax, to fund transportation projects throughout the region. (Expired 2008)

2004 – San Diego County voters approved a 40-year extension to the ½-cent sales tax. (Continues to 2048)

## Funding Split:

- 1/3 Transit
- 1/3 Highway
- 1/3 Local



# *TransNet Extension & Ordinance*

## PROP A

Required 2/3 vote in favor to pass

16 Highway Capital Improvement Projects identified in measure

- Estimated amount - \$6.7 Billion
- Ballot Language includes:
  - 11: Provide matching funds for construction purposes only for a tunnel from Glorietta Boulevard to Alameda Boulevard - \$25 million.

# CURRENT STATUS

- RECENT REVIEW OF TRANSNET REVENUE REVEALS ESTIMATED REVENUE CANNOT DELIVER ALL PROJECTS IDENTIFIED IN THE TRANSNET ORDINANCE
- CORONADO HAS REQUESTED THE ORDINANCE LANGUAGE BE CHANGED TO ALLOW THE \$25 MILLION TO BE USED FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS IN CORONADO
  - CHANGING THE TRANSNET ORDINANCE LANGUAGE WILL REQUIRE APPROVAL FROM SANDAG BOARD
  - SANDAG STAFF HAS RECOMMENDING ADVANCING AN IDENTIFIED PROJECT ALONG WITH THE REQUEST
