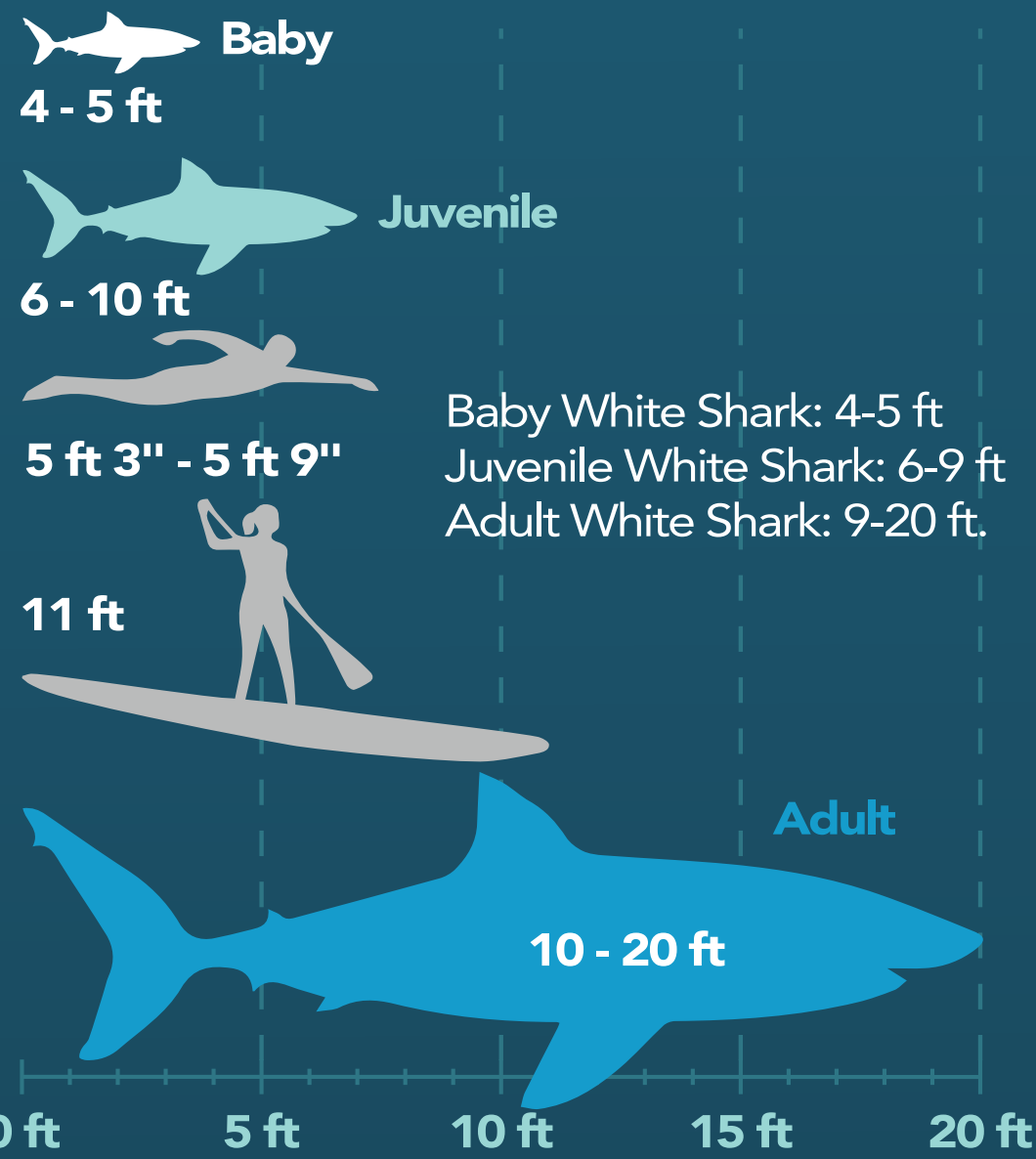


Shark Nurseries

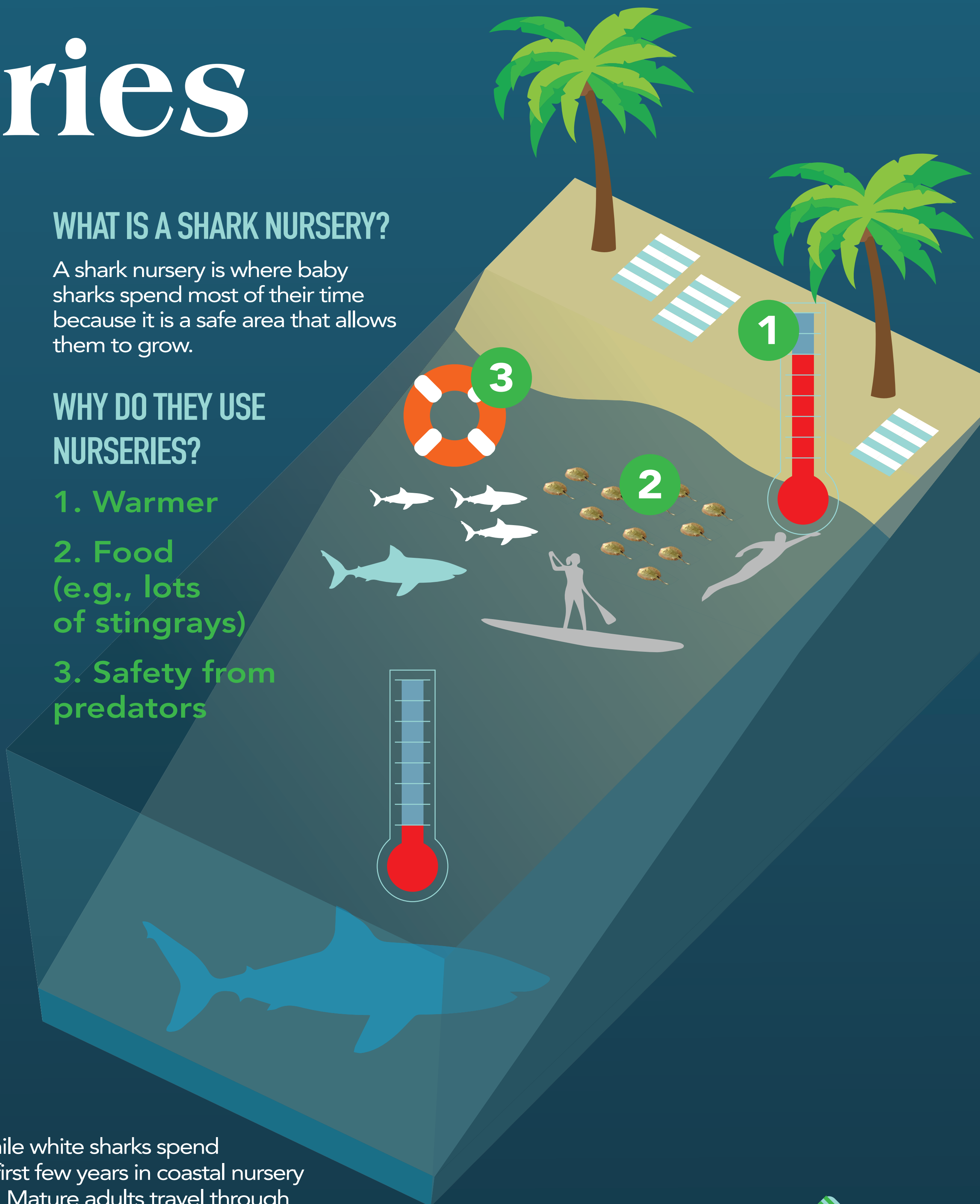


WHAT IS A SHARK NURSERY?

A shark nursery is where baby sharks spend most of their time because it is a safe area that allows them to grow.

WHY DO THEY USE NURSERIES?

1. Warmer
2. Food (e.g., lots of stingrays)
3. Safety from predators



ADULT AND JUVENILE WHITE SHARK HOTSPOTS



Juvenile white sharks spend their first few years in coastal nursery areas. Mature adults travel through comparatively deeper, cooler waters and spend most of their time at seal and sea lion rookeries.
