- Maximum Speed -CVC 22349 (a)
- Unsafe Speed-CVC 22350
- Reckless Driving-CVC 23103 (a)
- Loud Exhaust-CVC 27150 (a)
- Modified Exhaust Enforcement-CVC 27151

# LOUD MUFFLERS SAVE LIVES?



**FALSE!**

- The standard 100W siren for patrol cars puts out approximately 120 dBs of noise at 30 feet.
- How loud is 120 dBs?  
Chain saw = 100 dBs  
Rock Concert = 110 dBs

## So why don't people hear us coming?

## CVC 27150 and 27151

- **CVC 27150 (a)-Loud Exhaust**
- Every motor vehicle subject to registration shall at all times be equipped with an adequate muffler in constant operation and properly maintained to prevent any excessive or unusual noise
  
- **CVC 27151 (a)-Modified Exhaust**
- No person shall modify the exhaust system of a motor vehicle in a manner which will amplify or increase the noise emitted by the motor of the vehicle

# BRIGHT LIGHTS VS. LOUD EXHAUST



**You want drivers to see you.**

Use bright lights and auxiliary lights during the daytime to make you more visible.

## RIDE TO LIVE PROGRAM

The program's goal is to provide motorcycle operators with the skills to avoid or minimize collisions while enjoying their ride.

The course, taught by certified motor officers, focuses on the same riding techniques used by police motor officers every day. The class is 7 hours of "hands-on" motorcycle training, presented in one day, with lunch provided.

### What you will learn:

1. Proper use of the clutch and throttle "friction zone"
2. Proper head and eye placement during turning maneuvers
3. Low-speed maneuvering, balance, and control
4. Emergency braking
5. Collision avoidance skills
6. Counter steering and curve negotiation
