RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Applications are considered on a first-come, first served basis for available space. A waiting list will be available should demand exceed capacity.
- If demand exceeds space, annual storage rentals will be limited to two consecutive years, at which time a tenant must yield their space and may then add their name to the end of the waiting list to become eligible for another annual space.
- Spaces will be tentatively scheduled after the receipt of application and proof of Residency to qualify for Resident Rates (See Page 2 of Coronado Recreation Brochure).
- A security deposit of \$250 will be required for each vessel stored; deposits will be forfeited if user does not comply with storage policies.
- All vessels will be locked using City Provided Locks, no personal locks will be permitted.
- All users must be registered annually as Boathouse members, providing required emergency contact information and completing the orientation for safety and security procedures.
- Access to the Boathouse interior and exterior storage areas will only be available during operating hours; this policy is to ensure appropriate safety and security procedures are maintained at all times, for all Boathouse users.
- The City of Coronado will not be responsible for loss or theft. Proof of insurance must be provided for each vessel stored.
- No food or beverages may be stored in vessels; equipment stored in vessels must be dry.
- No hazardous materials, illegal substances, firearms or explosives may be stored in the facility.
- Vessels and other items remaining at the facility beyond the contracted rental period will be held by the Recreation Department until the owner settles outstanding fees. If equipment remains unclaimed, it will be turned over to the Coronado Police Department as lost property.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

The undersigned hereby agrees that in consideration of my use of the City of Coronado's boat storage space (the "storage"), I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Coronado, its elected and appointed officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers (the "City") from any and all causes of action, claims, liabilities, obligations, judgments, losses or damages, including reasonable attorney fees and costs of litigation ("claims") arising out of, or in connection with, my use of the storage. I further agree that neither I, nor any of my assignees, heirs, guardians, conservators or legal representatives will make any claim against the City arising from my use of the storage.

The undersigned further recognizes the inherent risks of damage to, or loss of, any property associated with my use of the storage, arising from any cause whatsoever including, but not limited to: fire, theft, vandalism, water damage, mysterious disappearance, rodents, acts of god, or the active or passive acts or omission or negligence of the City. The undersigned acknowledges such risks and hereby agrees to use the storage at my sole risk, excepting only loss, injury, damage or costs that arise out of the City's intentional wrongful acts or violations of law. I further agree and understand that all of my rights against the City under Section 1542 of the Civil Code of the State of California and any similar law of any state or territory of the United States are hereby expressly waived. Section 1542 reads as follows:

"A general release does not extend to the claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his/her favor at the time of executing the release, which, if known by him/her, must have materially affected his/her settlement with the debtor."

I acknowledge the City of Coronado does not have insurance which applies to any property damage or loss whatsoever that that I may suffer arising from my use of the storage and that I am solely responsible for obtaining any insurance desired at my own expense.

I understand that the above rules and regulations apply and that breaking any rules will result in the cancellation of my storage rental and forfeiture of my security deposit. I also accept the terms of the Release of Liability, Waiver and Assumption of Risk above.
