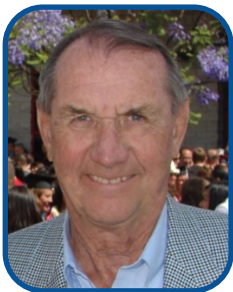

Family History Can Be Fun! Find out how Fun on Saturday, January 27 10:30 am in the Winn Room

Learn how to get started with your own genealogy project. Delbert Ritchart from the San Diego Genealogical Society has designed this free presentation for the beginning genealogist; but is also an excellent review for the more experienced researcher as well. He will discuss Genealogy Software programs and other tools for organizing and recording data about the members of your family tree. Additionally, several important web sites for conducting your research will be briefly explained. Tips for conducting and documenting your research will be provided and local research resources will be suggested. DNA has become a key tool for today's genealogist and Mr. Ritchart will provide some interesting anecdotal success stories relating to his use of DNA in finding "cousins."



Del Ritchart began researching his family history in 1994. He has served in leadership positions in several San Diego genealogy organizations; including President, Computer Genealogy Society of San Diego and Program Director, San Diego Genealogical Society. He is currently Chair of The Working Group for soliciting Sponsors, Exhibitors and Advertisers for the Fall 2019 International German Genealogy Partnership Conference to be held in Sacramento. Del has given over 100 genealogy presentations to numerous groups in the Southern California area in the past eight years. He published, "*Breathing Life Into My Family Ancestors*" in late 2011 and plans to publish a second book next year.
